

Welcoming guests to your Secure Access network



Your school's visitors aren't all the same and may require different access levels to your network depending on their role. You have several options available to best balance their need for access and your school's need to minimise security risks. You can control who has access to what (including printing and casting) and set reasonable limits on how long they have access and how many devices they can connect. Guest access can be fully managed in MyN4L which means generating Wi-Fi keys is faster and more convenient than ever.

Access type	A monthly Wi-Fi key is generated automatically for all guests to access Guest network - internet only . Control	Limited control - anyone with the Wi-Fi key has access to your school's network. Ability to reset the Wi-Fi key in MyN4L in case of a security concern.	Full control - each guest has their own unique key so you can see who's accessing your school's network.
